## **FINNAIR FLIES HIGH WITH THE A350**

Finnair's CEO Pekka Vauramo is set to share the airline's experience of the new Airbus A350 at an aviation industry lunch next week.

Finnair is the first carrier in Europe to operate the A350, deploying it on routes to Asia Pacific. He is also expected to outline Finnair's strategy for Asia in his speech to the UK Aviation Club on 9 November 2016, in London.

Finnair has been developing its Helsinki home base into a major hub for passenger traffic between Europe and Asia Pacific and it is now one of Europe's leading airlines serving China and Japan.

Jane Johnston, chair of the Aviation Club UK said: "Despite its home being one of most northerly European airports, with all the challenges of snow and ice, Finnair has established a record for being one of the most punctual airlines in the world. We look forward to hearing the secrets of their success and the role the new Airbus A350 is playing in its future plans."

The Fellowship of the Aviation Club UK - nominated by Committee members - is also to be formally awarded to Lord Glendonbrook\*, former chief of British Midland, at the lunch. The Fellowship recognises the outstanding, long-term contribution by an individual to the civil aviation industry in the UK.
